

### Year in Review - January to December 2022


The Presidential Youth Employment Intervention (PYEI) mobilises stakeholders from the public, private and non-state sectors to enhance coordination and accelerate efforts to transition young people from learning to earning at scale. ## Over 344 000 earning opportunities secured on SA Youth

The National Pathway Management Network (NPMN) is linking a growing number of young people to learning and earning opportunities. In 2022, 344 699 earning opportunities were secured by young people on SA Youth, the NPMN's flagship digital platform managed by Harambee Youth Employment Accelerator. Most of these were offered by Presidential Employment Stimulus programmes, notably the Department of Basic Education's school assistants programme.



An additional 40 053 earning opportunities were secured by young people on the Department of Employment and Labour's Employment Services South Africa platform.



## Over 45 000 young people serving in communities


For many of the 45 167 participants on the PYEI's Revitalised National Youth Service (NYS), the opportunity is the first time in their lives that they earn money of their own. The NYS is an avenue for young people to gain insights into different fields of work, build agency and contribute to their communities. The NYS is supported by the Presidential Employment Stimulus.

# Expanding workplace experience opportunities – with a focus on TVET graduates

The Youth Employment Service placed 30 460 young people in workplace experience opportunities in various sectors of the economy. In addition, the Department of Higher Education and Training placed 10 616 young TVET graduates into workplace experience opportunities in fulfilment of the State of Nation Address 2022 target of 10 000 graduates.





## Supporting young people to build their enterprises

Young people continued to receive direct support for their enterprises. A total of 39 111 financial and non-financial enterprise opportunities were provided by the Department of Business Development and the National Youth Development Agency.
